PLANES, PLANES AND MORE PLANES

Cobb County International Airport-McCollum Field (RYY), opened in 1960. Built as a reliever airport for Hartsfield-Jackson and DeKalb-Peachtree airports, it averages 262 take off and landings a day. The airport is home to 242 aircraft with the majority being single engine planes. Jets, multi engine, helicopters and gliders round it out.

Operational statistics: 44% local general aviation, 38% transient general aviation, 16% air taxi, 2% military

RYY is home to many businesses where you can store/detail/repair your aircraft, charter a plane and learn to fly or take a sunset biplane ride. If you just want to watch, you can view the activity from Aviation Park or while enjoying a meal at Elevation Chophouse.
