FALL COLOR ALERT

If you are out on a walk or driving home, slow down and take notice of a beautiful fall transformation in the neighborhood. For example, in front of 2163 Shillings Chase Drive is a 40+ foot ginkgo biloba or Maidenhair tree.

Ginkgo trees are an unchanged ancient species that have fossils dating back to the Jurassic period. Ginkgo trees are the one of the hardiest trees in the world. The leaf is a symbol of happiness and good fortune. Ginkgo leaves and seeds have medicinal uses but are not recommended for long term use.

Watch as this tree will transform from green to bright yellow, giving a vivid reminder of the changing season. Please be respectful. Do not pick any leaves or walk in the yard. Thank you to the Smith family for letting us highlight their tree.



Shillings Park is getting a remodel! Kennesaw Parks and Recreation Director, Steve Roberts confirmed that our neighborhood playground is getting an update.

"Work should begin in late October We will be replacing the swings, putting up a new border and mulch around the swings and playground. We are looking to add an addition play feature, with a border and mulch. We will also be updating the pavilion with a concrete pad and a new metal roof, along with a paint job. We will be spending around \$20,000 for the upgrades.
